Union County Player Wins \$263,720 in Quick Draw Game

TRENTON (April 1, 2026) – A New Jersey Lottery player in Union County won \$263,720 for 40% of the Quick Draw Progressive with a ticket purchased this morning.

Quick Draw Progressive tickets are sold at any New Jersey Lottery retailer and offer a fast way for players to see if they are winners.

Two Lucky Convenience Store, 154 Hillside Ave., Hillside, sold the winning ticket.

The current estimated jackpot is more than \$396,000.

How does the Quick Draw Progressive Jackpot work?

This rolling jackpot is available to every player at no additional cost. A set of nine “Your Jackpot Numbers” (01-80) are randomly selected and printed at the bottom of every Quick Draw ticket. If all nine of the player’s numbers are selected in any of the Quick Draw drawings that the ticket is eligible for, the ticket wins a portion of the Progressive Jackpot based on the amount wagered per draw.

A \$1 wager per draw ticket wins 10% of the jackpot, a \$2 wager per draw ticket wins 20% of the jackpot, and so on. Any ticket with \$10 wager per draw or higher will be eligible to receive 100% of the jackpot.
